

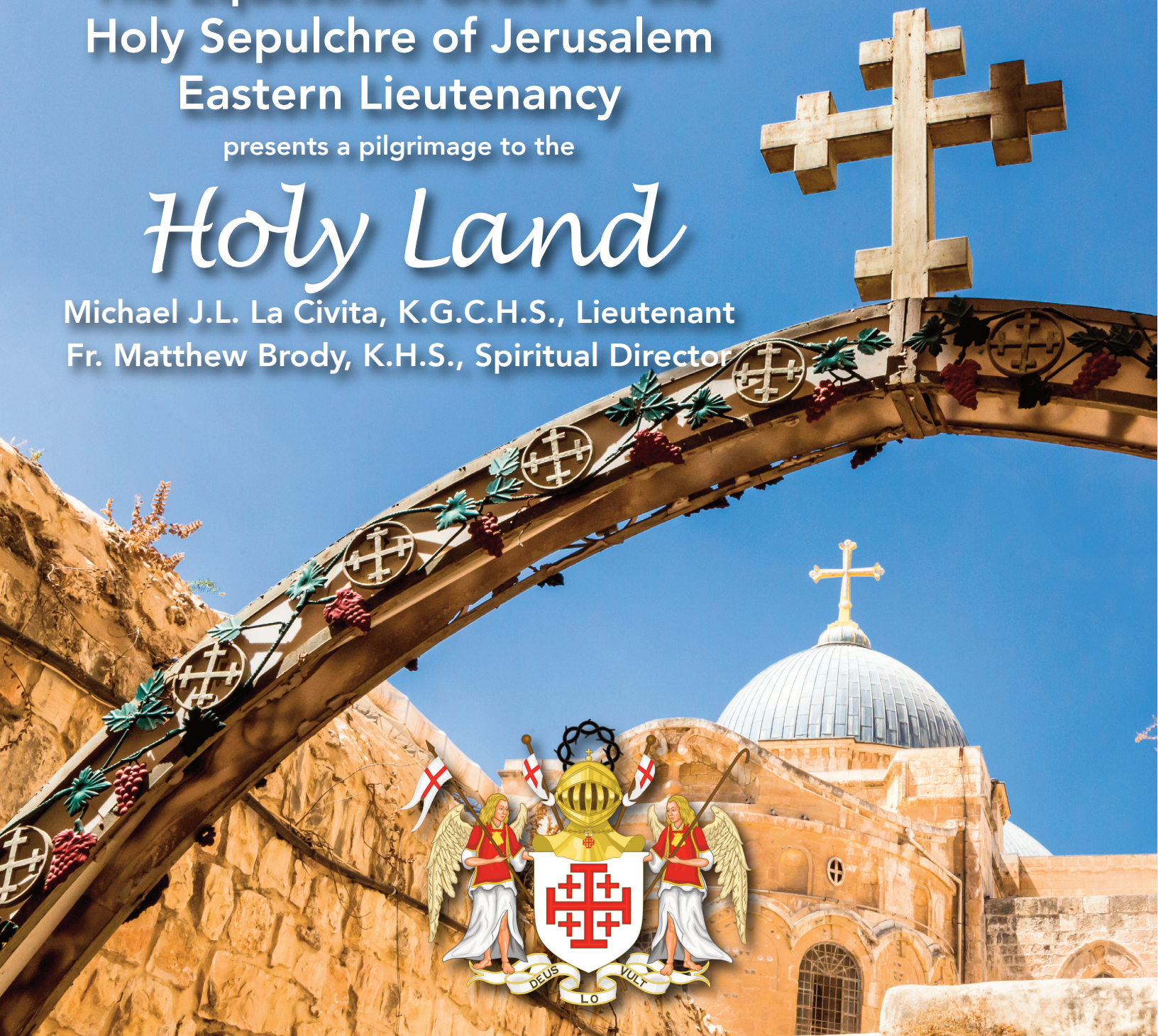

DAY 1 Monday, June 1: Depart USA

Depart New York JFK International Airport on our pilgrimage to the Holy Land. Complimentary dinner (D), breakfast (B), and beverages will be served.

DAY 2 Tuesday, June 2: Arrive in Tel Aviv | Caesarea Maritima | Sea of Galilee

Arrive at Ben Gurion Tel Aviv Airport, go through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and meet our Peter's Way Tour Manager/Guide upon exiting Customs. Board our comfortable touring bus and we will be on our way to Galilee. En route, we will stop at Caesarea by the Sea, site of a flourishing early Christian community where the ruins of Turkish, Crusader, and Roman Civilizations are still visible. Biblically, St. Paul was imprisoned here before being sent to Rome for trial. This is also where St. Peter baptized the first Gentiles.

We'll continue to the Sea of Galilee and check-in at the Magdala Hotel. Explore the archeological park with its first-century synagogue and Magdala Stone, one of the most significant recent archaeological finds in the Holy Land. See the Duc In Altum spiritual center that houses the Women's Atrium, Boat Chapel, Mosaic Chapels, and Encounter Chapel. **Celebrate Mass in the Boat Chapel.**

Dinner and overnight at the Magdala Hotel.

DAY 3 Wednesday, June 3: Nazareth | Cana | Mount Carmel

Theme: The Annunciation

Breakfast at our hotel. Begin our day with a visit to Nazareth, where Jesus spent his hidden years. We'll see the traditional synagogue that Jesus would have gone to as a young boy and as an adult. The highlight of our time in Nazareth will be a visit to the magnificent Basilica of the Annunciation built over the house of Our Lady. Here, "The Word became flesh and dwelt amongst us." We will contemplate the mystery of the Incarnation and explore the beautiful basilica built in 1968. Visit the house of the Holy Family and use the afternoon for prayer and reflection. **Celebrate Mass in the Basilica of the Annunciation. At noon, pray the Angelus with the local Franciscan community in the Grotto of the Annunciation. Group lunch at the Franciscan Casa Nova Guest House.**

Continue to Cana, where Jesus performed His first miracle. Visit the Wedding Church, built in the nineteenth century over ruins from Jesus' time. See the display of stone jars and reflect on the miracle of the changing of water into wine. Married couples will have an opportunity to renew their wedding vows. After our visit we'll continue to Mount Carmel (Vineyard of God) on the Mediterranean coast. Here the triumph of Elijah over the pagan prophets of Baal took place (1 Kings 18). Visit Stella Maris, the largest monastery of the Carmelite order, dedicated to the prophet Elijah and Mary, Our Lady of Mount Carmel.

Dinner and overnight at the Magdala Hotel.

DAY 4 Thursday, June 4: Around the Sea of Galilee | Caesarea Philippi

Theme: The Ministry of Christ in Galilee

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we will explore the area of Jesus' public ministry. Begin with a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee, where the Gospels come to life as we imagine when Jesus walked on the water (John 6:19-21), calmed a storm (Matt. 8:23-26), and showed the disciples miraculous catches of fish (Luke 5:1-8; John 21:1-6). We'll visit Tabgha, a popular fishing spot for locals because of its famous "seven springs" (Heptapegon). Tabgha is the traditional location for the calling of the disciples. Here, Jesus walked along the shore and called out to Simon, Peter, and Andrew, who were casting their nets into the sea. Visit the Church of the Multiplication and see the Byzantine mosaic of the loaves and fishes. **Celebrate Mass at the Church of the Primacy.** Continue to Capernaum. See the house of Peter's mother-in-law and the first-century synagogue where Jesus taught and performed miracles. We will discuss the development of synagogues in Jewish thought and theology to better understand their importance in the public ministry of Our Lord. Ascend the Mount of Beatitudes, where Jesus delivered the Sermon on the Mount. Group stop for lunch (cost not included).

Drive north to explore the upper regions of Israel to the foot of Mount Hermon, overlooking Syria and the Road to Damascus, where Jesus appeared to Paul. We will visit Caesarea Philippi and reflect in the place where Jesus looked at his disciples and said, "...But who do you say that I am?" (Matthew 16:15), and Peter's response to Jesus, "You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God." (Matthew 16:16). Return to Magdala.

Dinner and overnight at the Magdala Hotel.

DAY 5 Friday, June 5: Mount Tabor | Jordan Valley | Jericho | Taybeh | Jerusalem

Theme: The Transfiguration

Breakfast at our hotel, followed by check-out. Begin our day with a visit to Mount Tabor, sight of the ancient battle of the Israelite General Barak against the Canaanites and the sacred location where Jesus, with Peter, James, and John as witnesses, was gloriously transfigured. At the foot of the mountain, we'll take taxis to the top, where we will experience an utterly commanding view of the Galilee region. **Celebrate Mass at the Church of the Transfiguration.** Continue our journey through the Jordan Valley and marvel at the desert blooming with beautiful flowers, fruits, and vegetation.

We'll stop for lunch in Jericho (cost not included). After lunch we'll explore Jericho, home of Joshua, Elijah's spring, and the Mount of Temptation. We will see an old Sycamore tree and recall Jesus' encounter with Zacchaeus the Publican (tax collector). After we'll have a short visit at some of the ancient archeological ruins (the ancient Gates of Jericho [10,000 BC]). From there we will travel a short distance to a panoramic site traditionally referred to as the Mount of Temptation, the place of Jesus' temptations by the devil. Continue to Taybeh, the only Christian village in Palestine with a 100% Christian population. Upon arrival in Taybeh, visit the Beit

Afram Home for the Elderly, established in 2005 by the Latin Patriarchate of Jerusalem. Its mission is to offer a healthy environment for the elderly through its assistance of healthcare. Continue to Jerusalem.

Dinner and overnight at the Notre Dame of Jerusalem Guest House.

DAY 6 Saturday, June 6: Bethlehem | Shepherds' Field | Mount of Olives

Theme: The Nativity, Palm Sunday, and the Agony in the Garden

After breakfast, drive to the hills of Bethlehem to visit the traditional birthplace of Jesus in the Basilica of the Nativity. Here, the Prince of Peace was born! Venerate the silver star that marks the place where the sublime mystery of the incarnation was revealed in a manger! **Celebrate Mass at the Church of the Nativity.** Group stop for lunch (cost not included). Continue to Shepherds' Field, where we will see some of the caves that are typical of stables during the time of Jesus' birth.

Continue to the Mount of Olives, where we will visit the Church of the Pater Noster and walk the Palm Sunday route passing by the Shrine of the Dominus Flevit (The Lord Wept) and the Garden of Gethsemane. Visit the Church of All Nations to pray at the "Rock of Agony," a section of bedrock identified as the place where Jesus prayed alone in the garden on the night of His arrest. Continue to the Upper Room, site of the Last Supper and descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles. Visit Dormition Abbey, built to honor the Assumption of Our Lady. Continue to the Church of St. Peter-in-Gallicantu, built on the site of the Palace of Caiaphas, the High Priest. Here, Jesus was imprisoned and Peter denied the Lord three times. **After dinner, return to the Garden of Gethsemane for a Holy Hour of Eucharistic Adoration.**

Dinner and overnight at the Notre Dame of Jerusalem Guest House.

DAY 7 Sunday, June 7: Judean Wilderness | Bethany

Theme: The Wilderness

Breakfast at our hotel. **Celebrate Mass at the Church of the Agony in the Garden of Gethsemane.** Then we'll journey to the Judean Wilderness and the Jordan River, the traditional site of the baptism of Jesus by John the Baptist (Matthew: 3:13-17). It is also considered to be the place where the Israelites crossed the Jordan River and Elijah the Prophet ascended to heaven. We'll have the opportunity to renew our baptismal promises (Mark 1:9-11). After our visit we'll continue to the Dead Sea. Enjoy a panoramic view of Ein Gedi, where David hid from Saul's wrath and the locale of the Song of Songs. Time will be given to visit the Dead Sea with the opportunity to swim or float. Group stop for lunch (cost not included).

On our way back to Jerusalem we will stop at Bethany, where Martha, Mary, and Lazarus welcomed Jesus in their home. We also know of Bethany as the town of the house of Simon the leper. Here, Jesus was anointed, as if for burial, by a woman. Visit the traditional tomb of Lazarus.

Before dinner, we will have a briefing by **Joseph Hazboun, Regional Director for Palestine and Israel for the Pontifical Mission for Palestine (CNEWA).**

Dinner and overnight at the Notre Dame of Jerusalem Guest House.

DAY 8 Monday, June 8: Via Crucis | Latin Patriarchate | Ein Karem | Israel Museum

Theme: The Crucifixion, the Resurrection, and the Visitation

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we will walk in the footsteps of Jesus during his Passion. Start at the convent of the Sisters of Zion to see the Lithostrotos in the Chapel of the Flagellation, where Jesus was tried and condemned. Walk the Via Dolorosa to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, where time will be given for prayer and reflection. *Solemn Entry to the Holy Sepulchre is subject to confirmation.* Then, walk to the **Latin Patriarchate for an Audience with H.B. Pierbattista Cardinal Pizzaballa** (pending confirmation). Qualifying members of the Eastern Lieutenancy will be awarded the Pilgrim's Shell. Independent lunch.

This afternoon we'll visit Ein Karem, home of Elizabeth and Zachariah, and birthplace of St. John the Baptist. See the Church of the Visitation, one of the most artistic in the Holy Land. Verses from the Magnificat are engraved on the columns of the church, and on the opposite wall are ceramic tablets bearing verses from the Magnificat in forty-two different languages. Continue to the Israel Museum, which houses the Dead Sea Scrolls, important to our understanding and appreciation of the Bible. Explore a model of the city of Jerusalem as it was in the days of Jesus.

Dinner and overnight at the Notre Dame of Jerusalem Guest House.

DAY 9 Tuesday, June 9: Old City | Emmaus | Shrine of Our Lady of Palestine

Theme: The Early Years in Jerusalem

After breakfast, walk along the ramparts of the Old City of Jerusalem leading to St. Stephen's Gate, where we will visit the Church of St. Anne and Pools of Bethesda. Enjoy panoramic views of the Old City. Continue to visit the excavation of the Judgment Gate at the Church of Alexander Nievsky outside the Holy Sepulcher. We will explore all the chapels and area of the Basilica of the Holy Sepulcher. Group stop for lunch (cost not included).

Visit Emmaus (Abu Gosh) and recall the story in Luke's Gospel where Jesus appeared to His disciples on the road after the Resurrection. The disciples' encounter with the Risen Lord restored their hope and they were renewed in faith. With this in mind, we will continue to the Shrine of Our Lady, Queen of Palestine in Deir Rafat, where we will pray for the people of the Holy Land still in need of prayers and the heavenly intercession of the Virgin Mary, the Queen of Palestine. **Celebrate Mass at the Shrine.** Return to Jerusalem for our farewell dinner.

Overnight at the Notre Dame of Jerusalem Guest House.

DAY 10 Wednesday, June 10: Return to the USA

After an early breakfast, we'll be transferred to Ben Gurion International Airport in Tel Aviv for our return flight to the USA.

Acceptance of these Terms & Conditions, with signature on enrollment form, is required for participation in this tour.

PAYMENT: All payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order, or debit/credit card. **Peter's Way Tours (PWT)** reserves the right to increase the package price or reduce services should there be an escalation in the Israeli Shekel valuation over the U.S. Dollar in excess of 3% from print date. If a final payment is not received by the balance deadline, PWT reserves the right to cancel your reservation. A \$50.00 late fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Personal checks will not be accepted within 30 days of departure. If the bank returns a personal check, a \$50.00 processing fee will apply and subsequent payments must be made in the form of money order, certified bank check, or debit/credit card. PWT collects funds on travelers' behalf and remits those funds to suppliers. PWT has no liability for suppliers' acts or omissions. By signing this enrollment form, you agree you will not initiate a chargeback against PWT for any supplier's failure to refund or provide credit due to a forced cancellation of services.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS: All tour payments are non-refundable upon receipt. If you cancel from 99 days prior to departure up to the day of departure, all payments are non-refundable, including departure taxes & fuel surcharges, single supplement, deviation fees, travel insurance payments, or other costs. Travel insurance is recommended as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons (illness or injury). Travel insurance payments are non-refundable. Tour participation is non-transferable. Names cannot be changed on roster or airline tickets. All refund requests are subject to cancellation terms set forth above. Costs for tour services that are not utilized are non-refundable. We strongly recommend purchasing travel insurance in order to protect your tour package investment. Please read all details very carefully under TRAVEL INSURANCE.

LATE RESERVATIONS: Enrollments received after the deposit deadline are subject to confirmation. Late fees and a possible increase in airfare may apply.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: Each traveler is solely responsible for carrying a valid passport and ascertaining knowledge of current entry/exit requirements. **U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months after the return date. As of January 1, 2025, travelers to Israel must have ETA-IL approval before entering the country.** After enrolling you will be sent information to apply online for ETA-IL prior to travel (\$8 application fee not included in package price). Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current international travel requirements. Each traveler is solely responsible for ensuring that all required travel documents are complete and current. PWT will not be held responsible for a passenger's lack of current and valid entry documents (i.e., passport, proof of vaccine, any required test results).

AIR TRANSPORTATION: Optional group airfare to be confirmed via New York JFK International Airport. Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Estimated departure taxes & fuel surcharges are subject to increase prior to ticketing. All flights are booked under one itinerary. If a traveler does not travel on any one of the flights in the proper sequence, the rest of the reservation will be automatically canceled by the airline. Rebooking the canceled flight would be subject to a change fee and possible fare difference. If you purchase independent flights, PWT will not be held responsible for the cost(s) if you cancel participation for any reason. **It is important that you do not purchase airline tickets until the group has been confirmed for travel by PWT.**

AIRLINE SEATING: Under group contracts, seat selection is not permitted. Requests for seat preferences (window or aisle) may be made when you check in for the flight. There is no guarantee that requests will be honored. PWT cannot submit special seat requests on behalf of any passenger. Group reservations may not be accessed online for advance check-in/boarding passes/seat assignments. If seat selection is a condition that affects your decision to travel, it is suggested that you purchase the land only package in order to book your airline arrangements according to your specific needs.

LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: The Land Only package price is \$4,195.00 per person sharing a twin room (\$200 cash discount will be applied if all payments are made by check). The Land Only package does not include group airfare. It is the traveler's responsibility to book airline tickets independently. Any tour participant may change their status to "Land Only" by notifying PWT in writing, up to 100 days prior to departure. Passenger(s) opting for the Land Only package, or deviating from the group itinerary, are responsible for their own transfers to/from the hotel/airport. However, if your flights coordinate with the groups' arrangements, you are welcome to utilize the group transfer(s). **If you purchase your own airline transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel for any reason, PWT will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare.**

DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES: PWT is pleased to assist clients with special requests. Deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 100 days prior to departure. A deviation fee of \$150 plus any increase in airfare or additional fees may also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. Please contact PWT for more information.

TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE: Overseas round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the "all-inclusive" package for the group tour dates. Portage of one piece of luggage at hotels throughout your tour is included. Peter's Way Tours cannot be held liable for any misplaced or lost luggage. It is the passenger's responsibility to make sure their luggage travels with them the entirety of the trip.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: The package price is based on double occupancy (two twin beds). Married couples may request a double bed which is subject to availability. Triple rooms (two twin beds plus rollaway) may be requested, with no discount for triple occupancy. Single rooms may be requested at time of booking. Single rooms are limited, subject to confirmation, may be smaller, and located apart from the room block. **If a single room is confirmed, an additional charge of \$1,495.00 will apply.** We cannot guarantee roommate requests but will make every effort to pair you with another traveler, if double occupancy is requested. If a single room must be assigned due to lack of a traveler to pair you with, a roommate's cancellation, incompatibility, or any other reason (at the last moment or while on tour), you will be charged the single supplement.

MEALS: Breakfast and dinner daily, plus one (1) lunch.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities are not included in your tour package. **Gratuities for the tour manager, guides, and driver of \$150.00 per person will be billed with your final invoice.** All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the package price. Although service charges are included, it is customary to leave \$1.00 per person for the wait staff after each meal and \$1.00 per person per day for housekeeping.

TRAVELER HEALTH ADVISORY: Passengers must be medically and physically fit for travel and ensure that such traveling will not endanger themselves or others. Most pilgrimages entail a lot of walking, stairs, hills, cobblestone roads, etc. Tour buses are not equipped with wheelchair ramps. A traveler who requires special assistance must notify PWT and must be accompanied by a travel companion who will provide proper help. PWT shall not be held responsible if we are unable to accommodate passengers with special needs, or for the denial of services to a passenger by any carrier, hotel, restaurant, or other independent suppliers.
